Promote a sustainability culture at the heart of our Nursery School.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register with the Eco-Schools programme. • Set up an Eco Club involving all members of the nursery school community. Identify Eco Club leads. • Begin working through the Eco-Schools 7 step framework.
Conduct a Nursery Review.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore how eco-friendly your nursery is through completing 2 site reviews. 1 for children and 1 for adults. • Identify how our nursery can begin to reduce its carbon footprint, cut down on waste, and support biodiversity.
Embed Eco-Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eco-Club Leads plan and embed eco-themed learning experiences across the nursery. • Eco-Club Lead a hands-on eco-activity for children to get involved with and make a difference.
Sustainable Changes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff members in the Eco-Club to reflect on our Nursery Review findings and implement at least two sustainable changes to our site, policies, or operations.
Informing and Involving	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inspire the wider nursery community to act. Eco-Club inform others about our Eco-Schools' activities via methods such as newsletters, social media, or Tapestry. • Create opportunities for broader participation where possible.
Reflection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff support children to reflect on their activities and the skills that they have learnt.
Eco-Promise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eco-Club-leads support children to create an eco-promise – a call to action, letting the world know about your commitment to protecting the planet.
